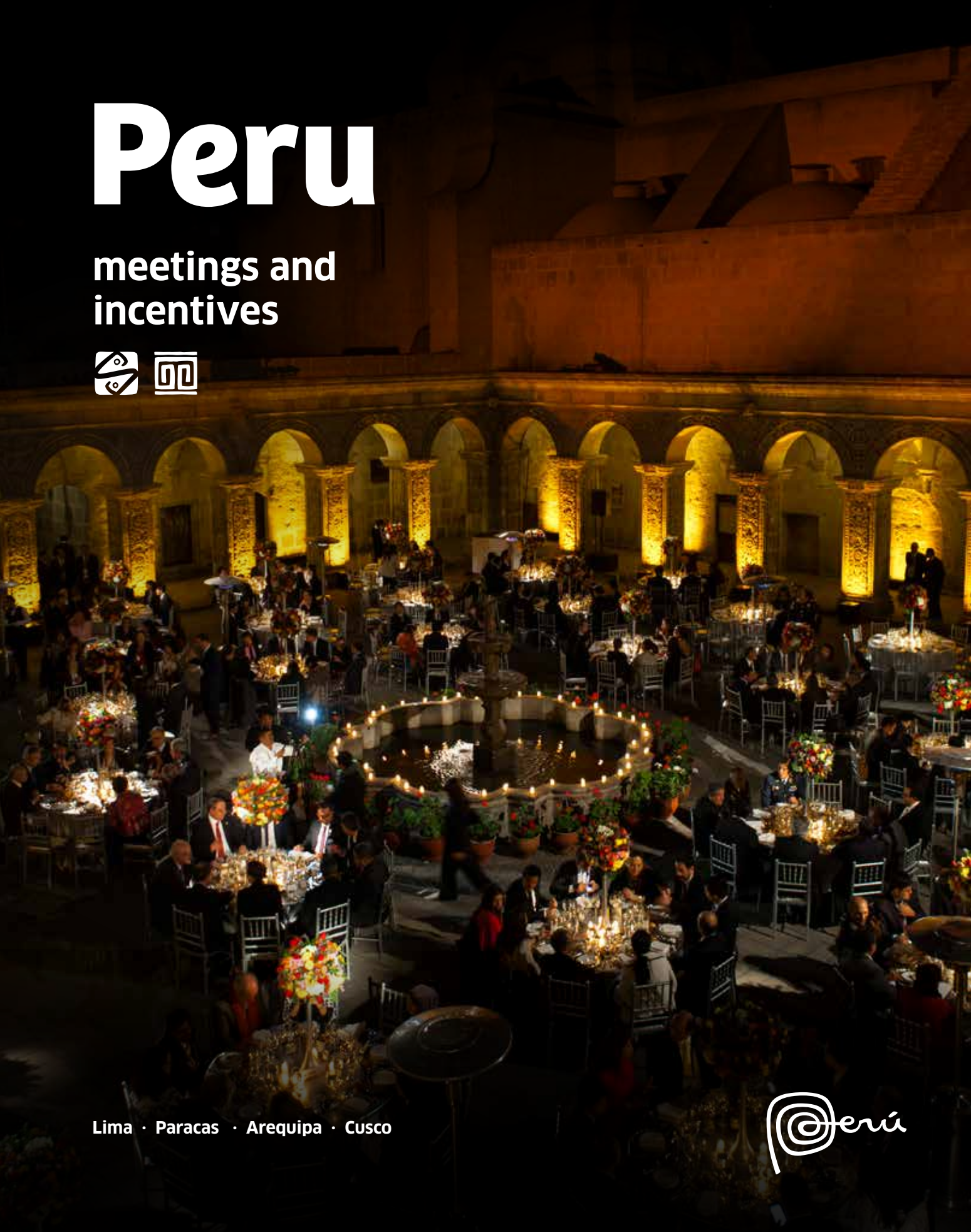

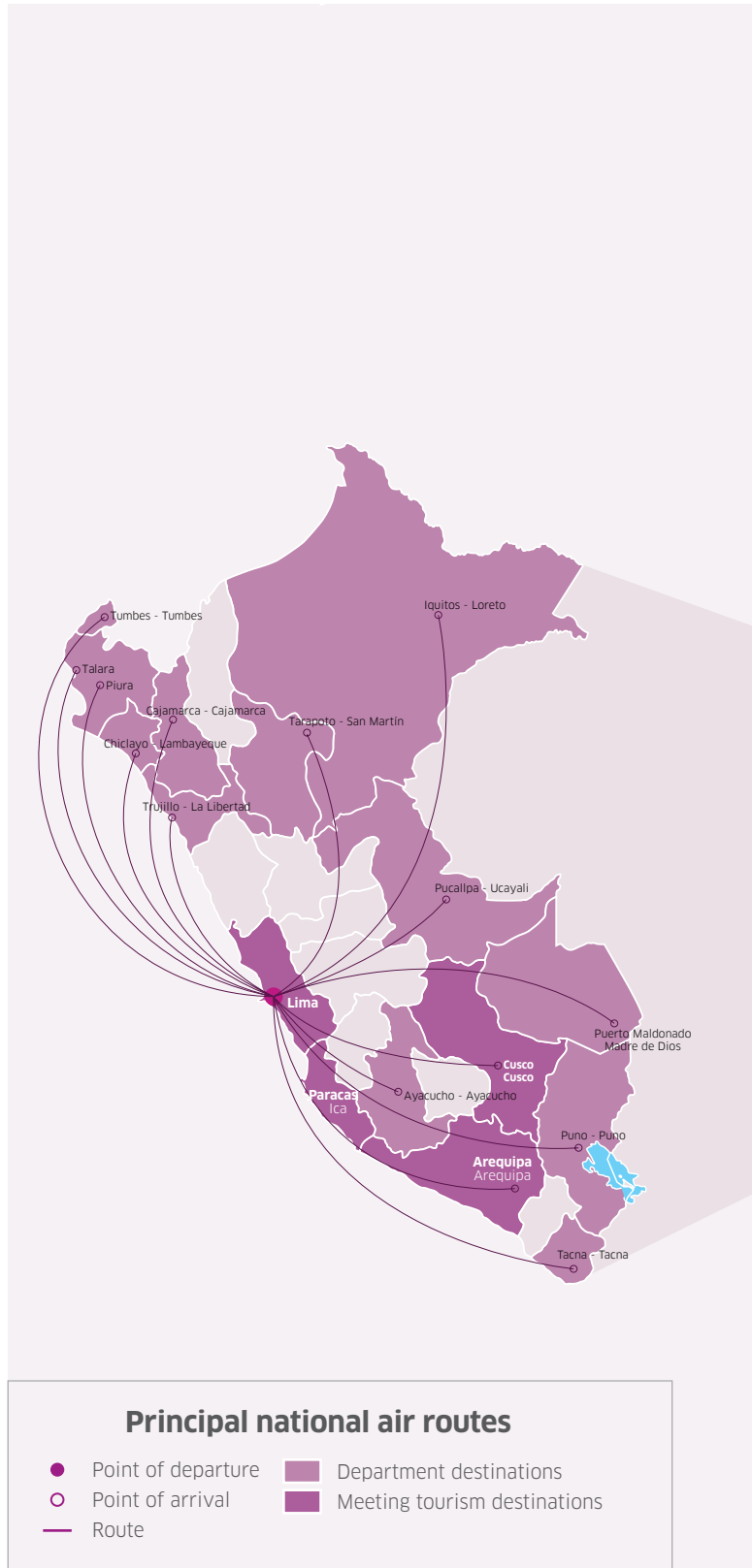


The region's hub

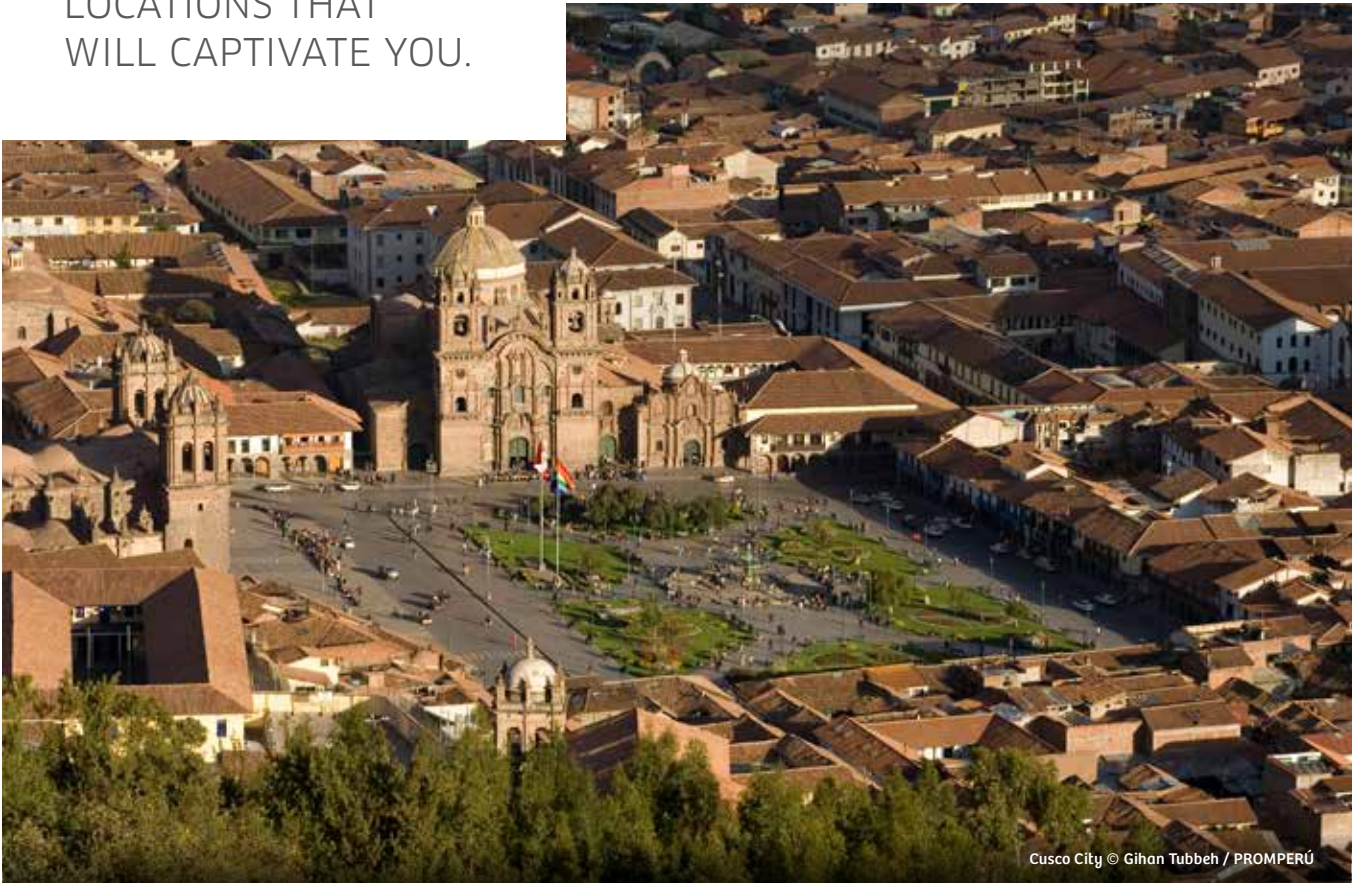

Center and Epicenter

Lima is filled with history. Its neoclassical and baroque architecture, in the form of museums and churches, affords the visitor a glimpse of our colonial past. In a single glance we can travel from the 17th to the 21st century. From the top of a modern building, we can cast our eyes towards the beauty and mystery of pre-Columbian temples; several ancient ceremonial sites known as *huacas* dot the urban footprint and form part of the itinerary of many city tours.

Impressive ocean views are available from a splendid promenade that runs almost the length of city along the cliff top; it is here that the gentle sea breeze can accompany a pleasant stroll or a bicycle ride. Lima has been growing continuously for more than fifteen years, a boom driven primarily by domestic and foreign private investment, especially in the tourism sector.

Having hosted many major events over recent years, the capital has developed modern infrastructure that is capable of rising to the demands of any occasion. The entertainment sector has also expanded and now offers options that surpass expectations.

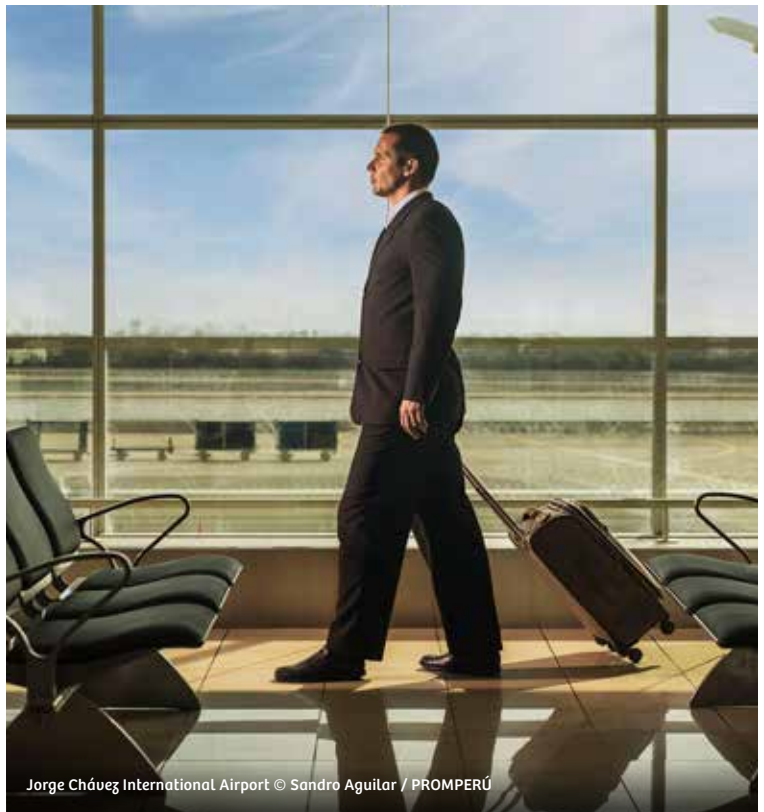

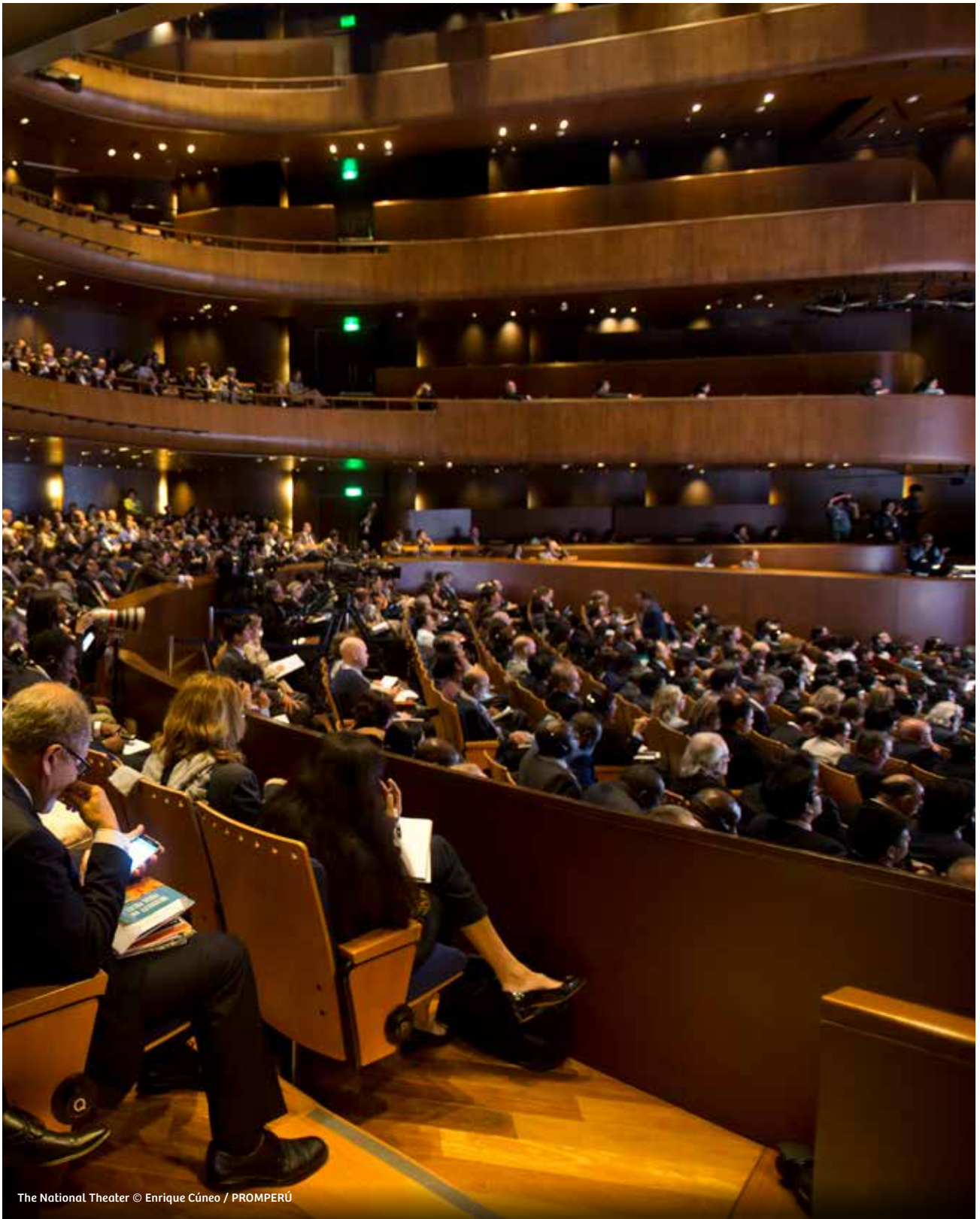

Lima Convention Center

THE HOME OF CORPORATE EVENTS IN THE CITY HAS A CAPACITY OF UP TO 10 THOUSAND PARTICIPANTS. ITS LOCATION IS EXCEPTIONAL AND EASILY ACCESSIBLE FROM ANY POINT OF THE CITY.

Opened in 2015 to host the Annual Meeting of the Boards of Governors of the World Bank and the International Monetary Fund, the Lima Convention Center is the largest multi-event space in the country. Surrounded by the National Museum, the Ministry of Culture, the Ministry of Education, the National Library, and the National Theater, the Lima Convention Center is easily accessible from anywhere in the city.

With a place for everyone

Displaying modern architecture, the center is a cultural and economic engine for the city and here you can hold large-scale activities in close proximity to Lima's most lively areas. The center's design successfully connects with collective Peruvian culture and has become an architectural milestone that offers the latest technological developments and all creature comforts.



The Lima Convention Center can accommodate up to 10,000 people. The modular nature of the meeting facilities enable to the user to vary the layout by opening or closing panels. Up to twenty-two meeting and conference rooms can be configured.

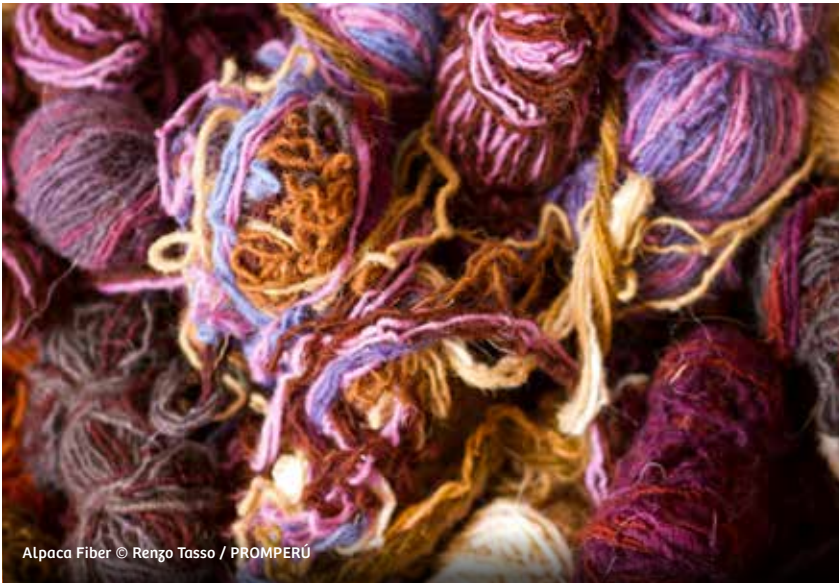

The climate along this coast is mild and the beaches are bathed by calm and gentle waves that resemble those of a lagoon. The Paracas National Reserve is proof of the region's biodiversity. This area, protected by the State, conserves a representative sample of the world's richest marine ecosystems. The Ballestas Islands are home to sea lions; to Humboldt penguins; and to birds, such as the guanay, the booby, and the Inca tern.

These items consist of ornaments made with gold, like those once produced for Paracas royalty, mirrors made of silver, and plates and drinking vessels that include copper elements.

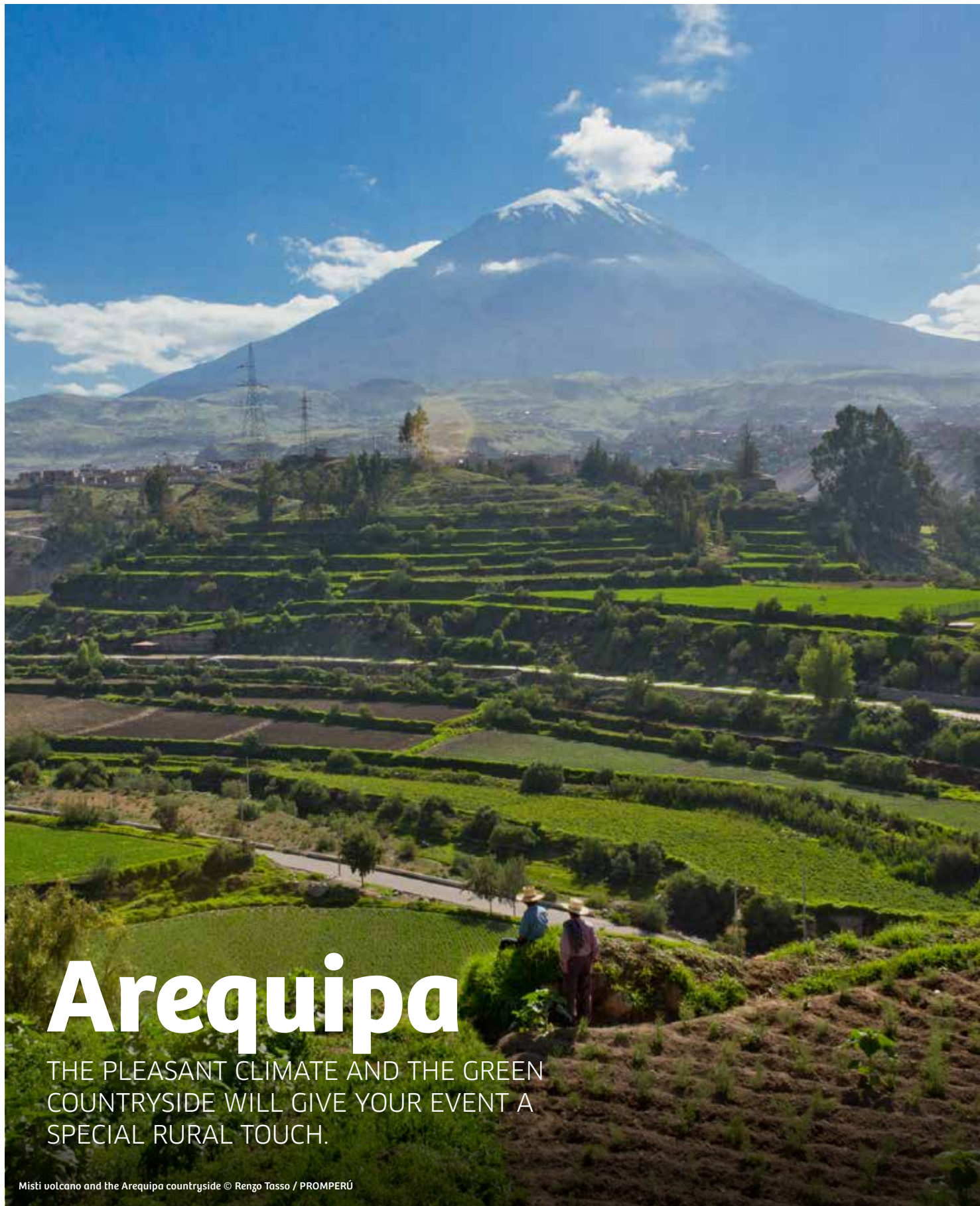

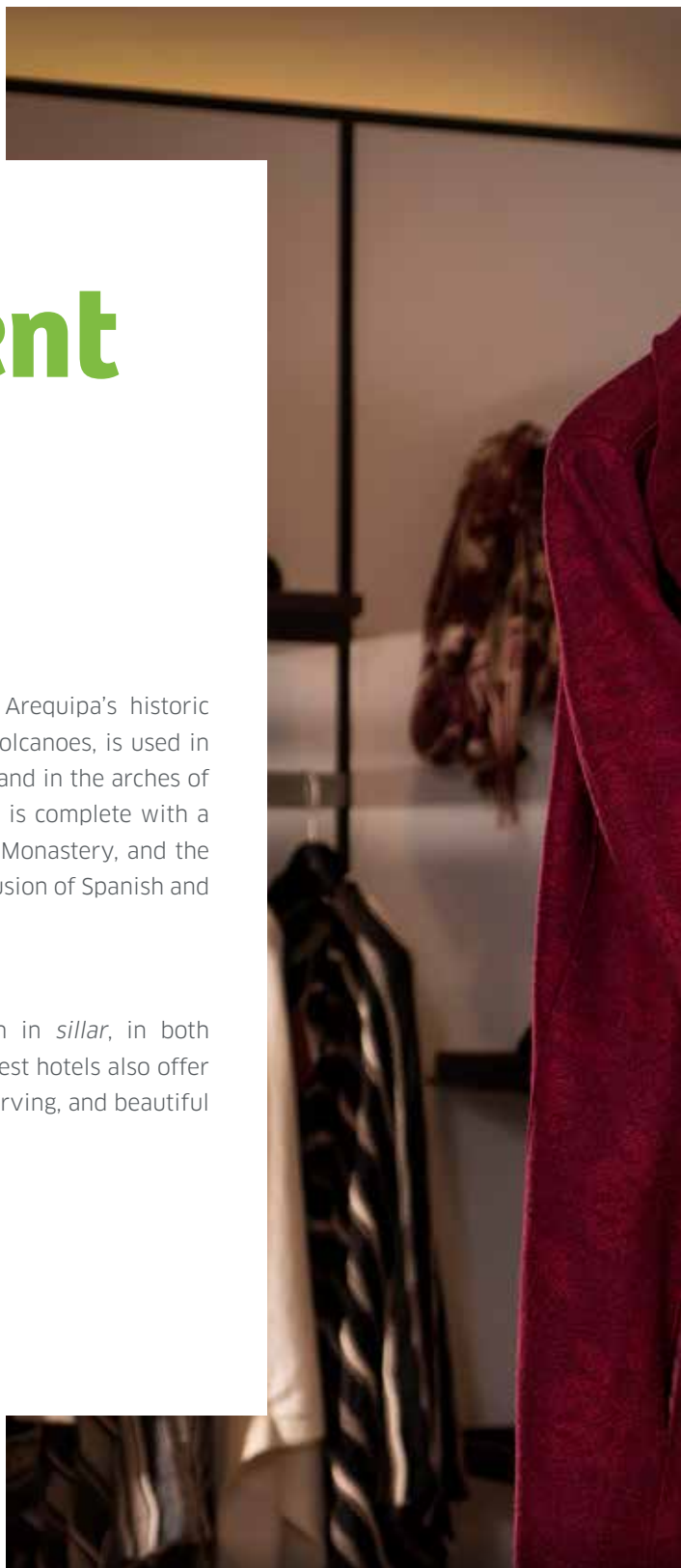

No visit to Arequipa is complete with a tour of the city's religious sites, such as the Santa Catalina Monastery, and the church and convent of San Francisco, both examples of the fusion of Spanish and Andean construction.

Arequipa crafts are known for their delicate preparation in *sillar*, in both traditional and modern finishes. Handicraft stores and the best hotels also offer alpaca fiber textiles, copper embossing, leather and wood carving, and beautiful embroidery using ancestral techniques.

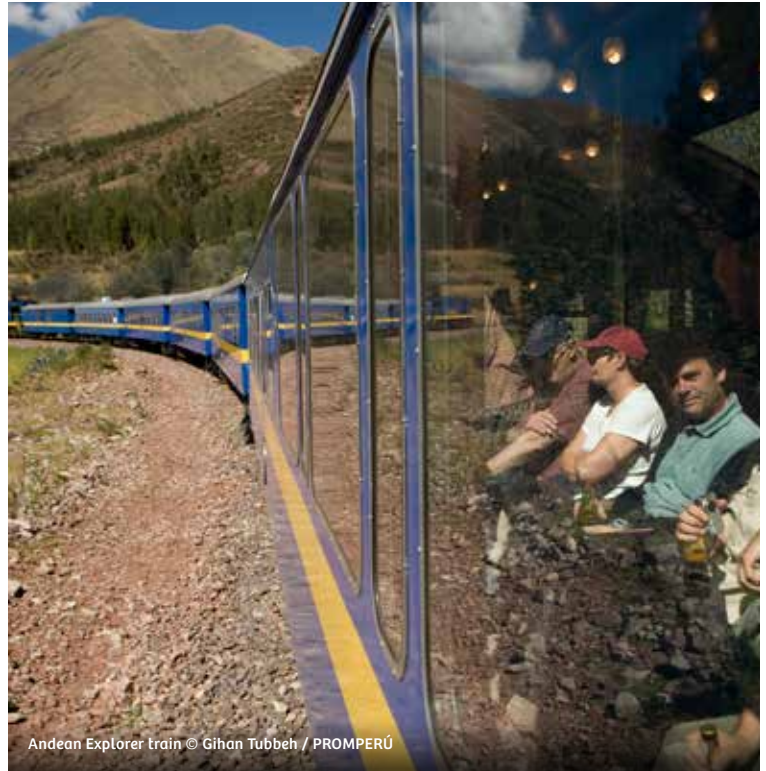

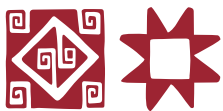

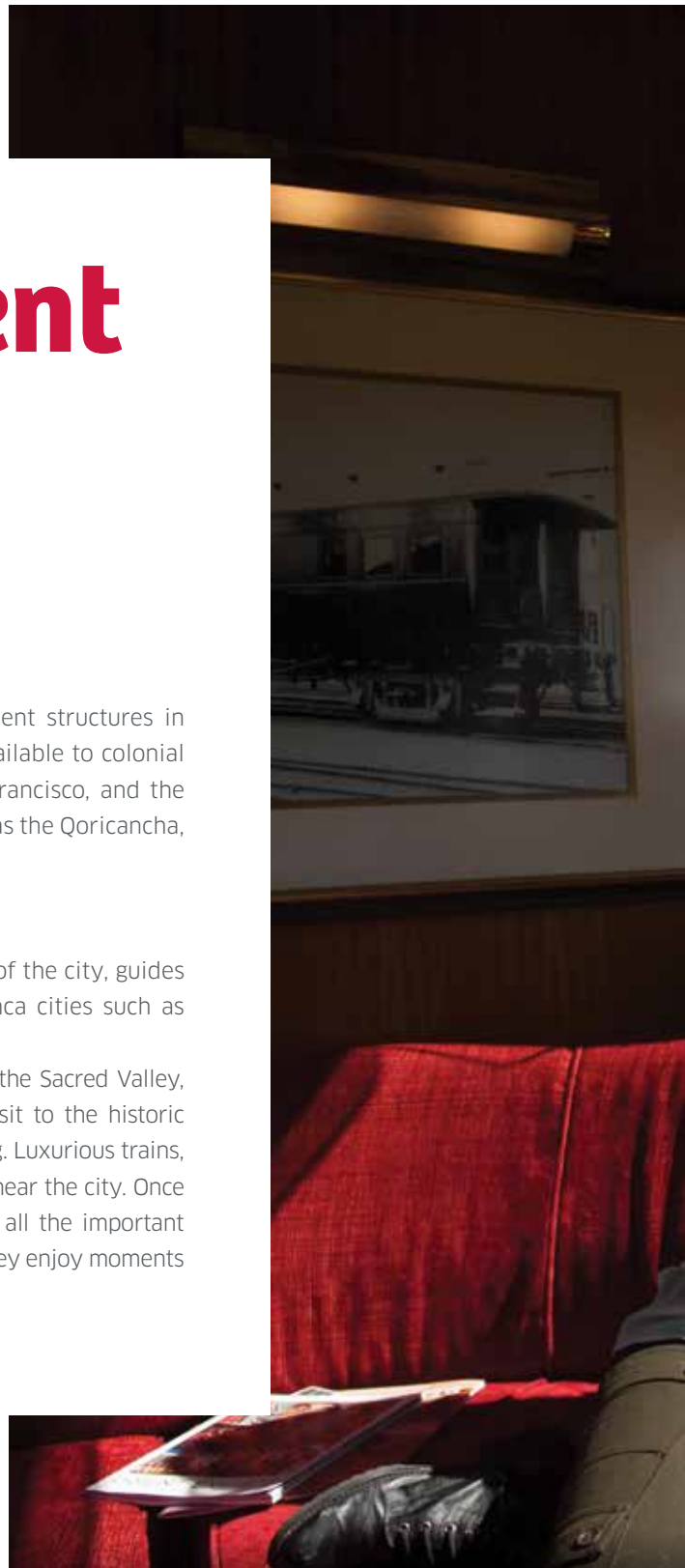
Dream Tours

If more free time is available, tours can reach citadels in the Sacred Valley, such as Pisac, Chinchero, and Ollantaytambo. Naturally, a visit to the historic sanctuary of Machupicchu is almost obligatory, time permitting. Luxurious trains, each targeting a different segment, leave every day from the near the city.
